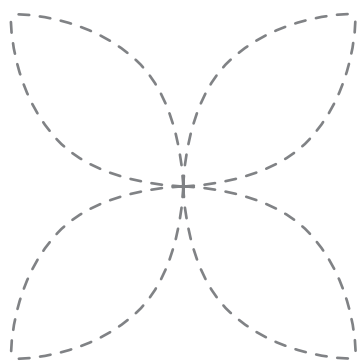


Peppermint Patty

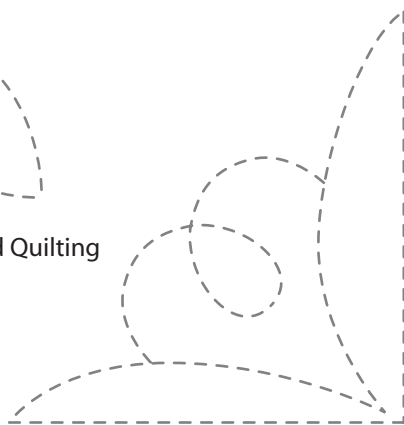
A web extra from Quilter's Newsletter Magazine

Georgina B. Fries used four hand-quilting motifs to finish *Peppermint Patty*, patterned in the November 2005 issue of *Quilter's Newsletter Magazine*. To mark these motifs, first press the quilt top thoroughly. Then mark the Scroll quilting motifs in the D and E patches. Center and mark the Pumpkin Seed quilting in the B's. Starting in the corner of each green print border and working toward the center, mark the borders to fill. Adjust the spacing as needed.

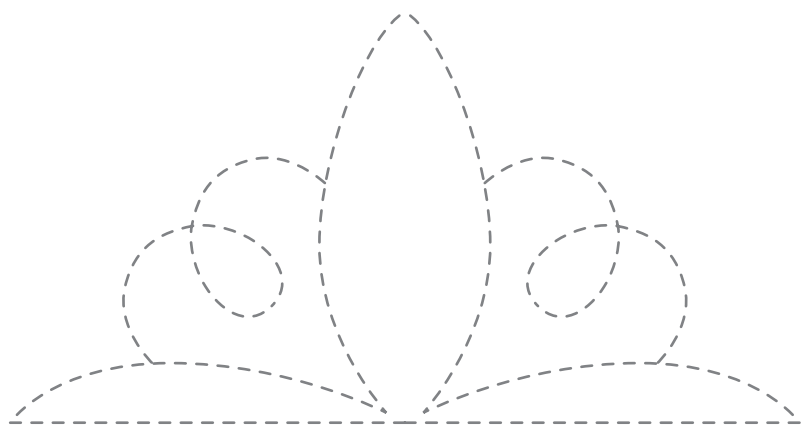
Layer and baste. Quilt the marked motifs, outline quilt the borders and B patches, and quilt diagonal lines in the pink A's.



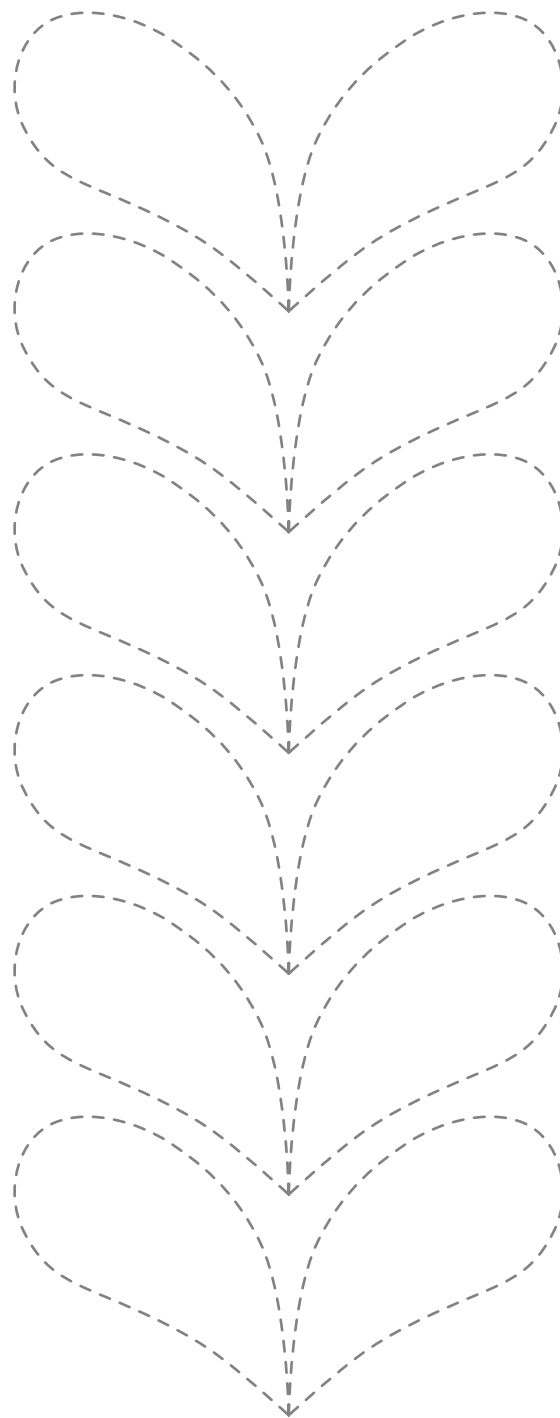
Peppermint Patty Pumpkin Seed Quilting

The Z blocks in this *Peppermint Patty*, patterned in the November 2005 issue of *Quilter's Newsletter Magazine*, can easily be paper pieced. If you prefer this method, make 81 copies of the foundation pattern. Piece each foundation in numerical order. Trim excess fabric and paper on the outside seam line.
