

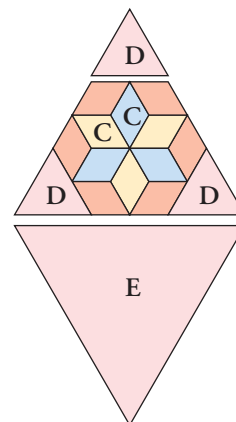
Six-pointed Stars

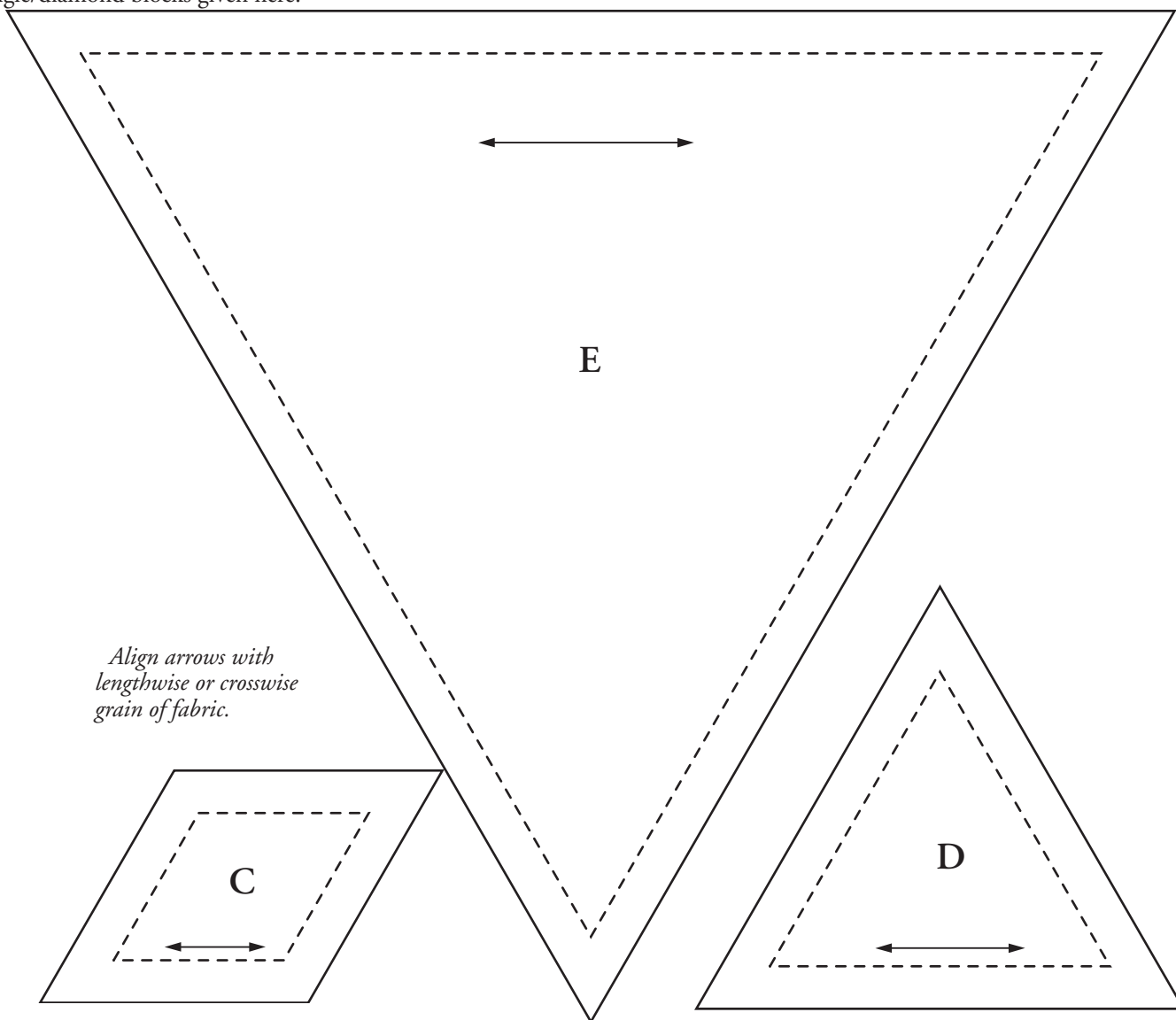
Ann Feitelson's technique for machine sewing six-pointed stars was presented in our November 2005 issue *Quiltmaker's Workshop*. If you'd like to make more of her star blocks, use the templates presented here to make the star-in-a-triangle blocks.

Join 3 C star patches and 3 background patches to make a hexagon star as described in the issue. Sew 3 triangle D patches (small triangles) to every other side of the star. Join this block with 2 triangle E's (large triangles) as shown to make the star-in-a-triangle/diamond block.

Have fun creating your own stellar quilt by mixing the star-in-a-triangle/diamond blocks presented in the issue and the star-in-a-triangle/diamond blocks given here.
