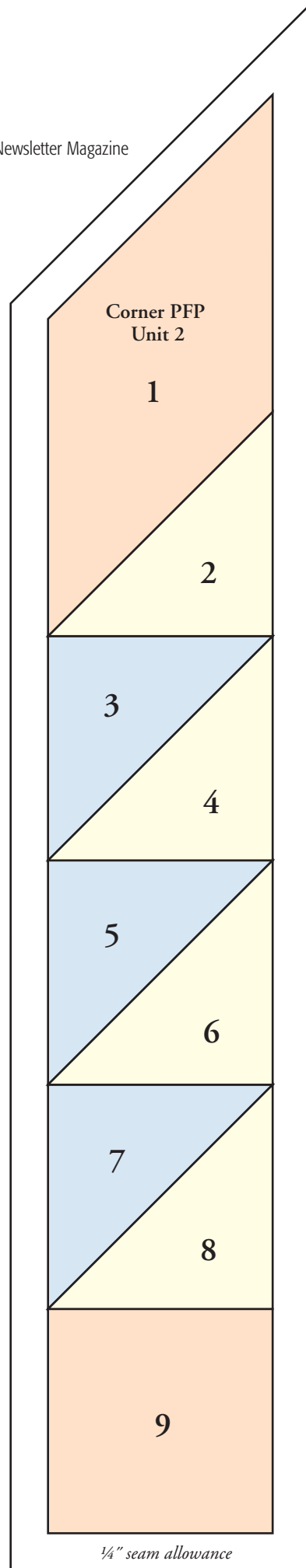
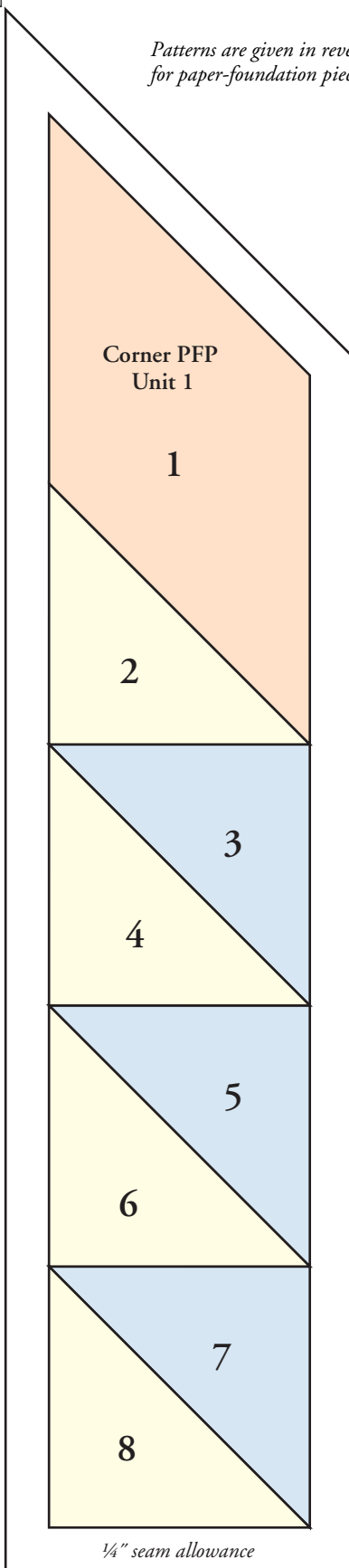

Flying Geese surround a Feathered Star in the southwestern-flavored *Autumn Sky* series quilt. Directions for Part One appear in *Quilter's Newsletter Magazine* no. 387 (November 2006).

Use these paper-foundation units in place of the D, E, and F patches for the Feathered Star. Print each unit 4 times. To be certain that the pattern is printing at 100 percent, patch nine finishes 1½" square. Use foundation-piecing methods to make each unit. Remove the paper. Follow the diagrams in the issue to complete the corner and side units.
